Reports and payments should be submitted by mail to the Town of Occoquan, P.O. Box 195, Occoquan, Virginia, 22125, or in-person at Town Hall Monday through Friday between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Reports and payments mailed must be *received* by the 20th to avoid incurring penalties.
